FOR THE HIGHER EDUCATION OF WOMEN

The Reid Trust was founded in 1868 in connection with Bedford College for Women for the promotion and improvement of women's education.

The trustees meet annually in July to decide on approximately six to ten awards of value £250 - £1000 each.

Applications are invited from women educated in Britain who have appropriate academic qualifications and who wish to undertake further training or research in the United Kingdom at any appropriate educational establishment.

Women wishing to be considered for an award should send the following details:

- Name, address and date of birth.
- Marital status, family commitments.
- Education: schools, colleges, universities attended with dates, examination results, professional qualifications.
- Brief details of the intended course/study.
- Amount of grant applied for. Please give details of available financial resources and estimated expenses.
- Please list other funding applied for and whether this has been successful if known.
- Please enclose **two written references**, one of which should be from a tutor or supervisor, and confirmation of your acceptance for the intended course.
